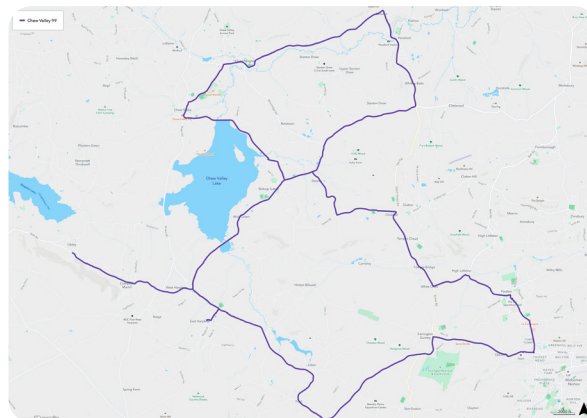

This (apparently cat-shaped) circular route runs around the Valley through the day, so you can get between villages, out to New Manor Farm & Farrington Farm shops, and Tesco.

*You can use it to get to **Pensford**, where you can link up with the **172** service (go to bcvcp.uk/172bus for details) to get to/from **Bath & Bristol**.*

*or from **Pensford**, the **376** service (bcvcp.uk/376bus) to get to/from **Bristol & Wells**.*

*Or travel to **Paulton** to connect with the **522** service (bcvcp.uk/522bus) to get to/from **Bath**.*

There are also some late night times on Friday's & Saturday's.

We've highlighted all the times the bus stops in Bishop Sutton - which is at the top of Ham Lane, outside the Post Office (sometimes on the other side of the road).

Dogs are allowed on the buses.

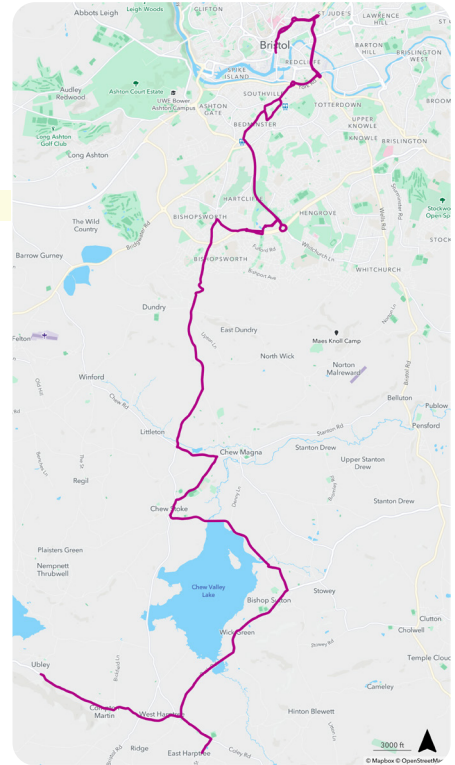

This service runs from the Valley & into Bristol, and back again, three times per day.

We've highlighted all the times the bus stops in Bishop Sutton - which is at the top of Ham Lane, outside the Post Office.

Dogs are allowed on the buses.

From Bristol you can catch buses or trains to Bath & across the region.

WESTlink

WESTlink is a new type of bus service which operates across our region. It runs without a fixed timetable or route, and is booked 'on demand' by users through the WESTlink app (in the App & Play stores), website (at travelwest.info/westlink), or by phone (on 0117 457 8561). You can travel anywhere within the Chew Valley Zone, as well as the A37, Hengrove, & airport shared zones, seen here.

To get to Bath or Bristol, advice from travelwest is to book WESTlink to get you to *Pensford*, then interchange with the 172 *Bristol-Bath* bus service: you can find the timetable for that at bcvcp.uk/172bus. From *Pensford* you can also use the 376 service (bcvcp.uk/376bus) to get to Bristol or **Wells**.

It's best to book the day before & you'll have to book your return WESTlink trip at the same time, or you could be stranded. You also need to be careful with timings, as the 172 service operates for longer through the day than WESTlink. Concessionary cards are accepted after 9am. Service dogs are welcome, but any other pets may need to be in an "airline-approved carrier".
