You can drive your car to your pitch to unload, but from then on cars are left in a car park at the bottom of the

site. As well as creating more space

around the pitches, this means you won't disturb or be disturbed by other quests closing car doors or starting up.

All of the pitches are fully serviced hardstandings set among trees and hedges. Instead of a washblock, there are numerous small washrooms. Each houses a toilet, shower and basin, and all are heated. Dishwashing sinks and a launderette are also provided.
